Writing Rangers (Teachers):

Adventures in Writing Camp is seeking creative and credentialed teachers to inspire campers through writing instruction. The ideal candidate loves wearing costumes, and probably has an overflowing costume box they wish they could use more often! You will deliver one 50 minute lesson four times (once each to grades 1-5). You will have 30 to 60 minutes of morning preptime (depending on the day's schedule). Though we will provide you with materials and lesson plans to lead your sessions, we will empower you to bring your own personality and interests to these activities. A local college student, or "Adventure Guide," will be available to support you. We anticipate a ratio of approximately 1 teacher to 16-20 students.

This is a 2 week commitment for the summer of 2016 with the option of working more weeks if desired. Going forward, teacher "alumni" will have an inside track on leadership positions as the camp expands to other locations in the area during the summer.

Over the course of two weeks, Writing Rangers will spend approximately 17 hours leading writing activities. The teacher's schedule also includes 5.5 hours of paid prep time, 3.5 hours of paid lunch break, 2.5 hours of greeting families at drop-off and pickup times, and 1.5 hours of meetings. The Writing Ranger will be on site from 8:15am – 3:15pm.

Compensation: Writing Rangers are considered employees, and pay is competitive with other top educational day camps. For the sake of the kids' experience, it is expected that applicants plan to be available all ten days of camp.
